2015 VINTAGE

The 2015 growing season began with record setting rains in December, followed by the driest January on record. There were no hard freezes during the winter, which contributed to a very early budbreak (late February in some spots). Rain in April shattered the flowers which caused a reduction in crop size, but that's just Mother Nature's way of thinning the crop. With a lighter crop the grapes ripened quickly and evenly, then violá, an early harvest!

2015 TASTING NOTES

The first aromas out of the glass are ripe and tropical with some lively citrus undertones and a hint of orange blossom. First sip is round and lush with juicy pineapple, and sweet summer peach flavors laced with ripe Meyer lemon. The finish is clean and crisp with lingering citrus and balanced acidity.
